August 26, 2020

A rescheduled regular meeting of the Norway City Council was held August 26, 2020. In order to help stop the spread of the COVID-19 virus, this meeting of the Norway City Council was available electronically for public participation by calling the number provided in instructions on the posted agendas.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Bruce Volz at 6:00 PM. Roll Call – Present: Jay Hahn, Kevin Frese, Darrell Schulte, Loras Schulte. Absent: Curtis Mell.

Motion L. Schulte seconded by D. Schulte to accept agenda, minutes and bills presented. Motion carried, 4-0.

Park Director Mike Schulte was present to discuss repairs needed to the park after the recent storm damages. Volunteers are needed to get the pavilion closed before winter as well as help with removal of branches.

Mayor Volz gave an update to the debris removal and steps going forward for assistance. Still waiting on the status of a grinder/chipper from the state.

Discussion was held on the status of WWTF included the status of the final pay request. Nick Eisenbacher with Snyder & Assoc. will present the request at the next meeting.

Animal Control ordinance will be worked on the remove breed specific animals and clarify dangerous animal attacks.

Building Permits were issued for a driveway extension at 409 Park Dr, deck at 204 E Johnson St, Shed at 401 Evergreen St. Motion L. Schulte seconded by D. Schulte to approve a 30x32' garage with attached breezeway at 308 Main St. Motion carried, 4-0.

Motion L. Schulte seconded by Frese to approve a Special Event Liquor License for Prairie Creek Saloon on September 12, 2020 from 6-11PM. Motion carried, 4-0.

Motion L. Schulte seconded by Frese to allow for drilling at fire hydrant on Railroad St. Motion carried, 4-0.

An ordinance allowing the use of ATV-UTV's on certain designated street will also be drafted for council review as well as a no parking on W Railroad St. Trailers and boats parked on city streets will also be added on the agenda.

Motion L. Schulte seconded by Frese to adjourn at 7:20 PM. Motion carried, 4-0.
