December 9, 2020

A rescheduled meeting of the Norway City Council was held December 9, 2020. To help stop the spread of the COVID-19 virus, this meeting of the Norway City Council was available electronically for public participation by calling the Free Conference Call number provided in instructions on the posted agendas.

Regular rescheduled meeting of the Norway City Council was called to order by Mayor Bruce Volz at 6:00 PM. Roll Call – Present: Darrell Schulte, Loras Schulte, Kevin Frese. Present electronically: Jay Hahn, Curtis Mell. Absent: None.

Motion L. Schulte seconded by D. Schulte to accept agenda, minutes and bills presented. Motion carried, 5-0.

Engineer Nick Eisenbacher with Snyder & Assoc. was present for discussion on WWTP status. The City has still not received any lien waivers from Boomerang. Waiting for guidance from attorney on steps to follow after waivers are received. In other business Eisenbacher presented information on Water Distribution Pressure. Map presented showed the current water pressure throughout town. A second map showed areas that need to be boosted to maintain 35 PSI. Motion L. Schulte seconded by Frese to proceed with submission of a plan to the DNR and begin work on a Low to Moderate Income (LMI) Study to try for qualification of grant funds. Motion carried, 5-0. Mell joined the meeting in person at 6:30 PM.

Motion L. Schulte seconded by Mell to purchase security cameras and apply for reimbursement through an ICAP grant. Motion carried, 5-0.

Mayor Volz presented a request for a building permit from 409 Park Dr for a 10 x 12 hoop building and 115 E Railroad St for a 10 x 17 hoop building. Motion Mell seconded by Frese to deny the permit per code standards limiting a shed to a size of 100 sq. ft. Motion carried, 5-0.

Resolution 20-09 Accepting FY-20 Street Finance Report was introduced by L. Schulte seconded by Mell. Motion carried, 5-0.

Several concerns were heard on nuisance situations. Mayor will send letters to the properties in violation.

Motion L. Schulte seconded by Frese to adjourn at 7:05 PM. Motion carried, 5-0.
