

RESOLUTION 22-02

RESOLUTION REGULATING PARKING ON THE PUBLIC STREETS OF THE CITY OF NORWAY  
TO FACILITATE SNOW REMOVAL

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 69.13 of the Code of Ordinances – Norway, Iowa states no person shall park, abandon or leave unattended any vehicle on any public street, alley, or City-owned off-street parking area. When any vehicle is left parked for more than 24 hours after a snowfall and the vehicle has been plowed around, a phone call shall be placed to the last known registered owner in an attempt to have the vehicle removed before it is towed. If the vehicle is not removed 24 hours after contact is made or attempted to be made, the vehicle may be towed.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Norway deems it necessary that on the basis of winter weather conditions, that parking be restricted or prohibited during snow removal of one-inch (1”) or more,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORWAY, IOWA AS FOLLOWS:**

1. A traffic control plan to facilitate snow plowing/removal during snow removal winter months requires all obstacles and motor vehicles, trailers, wagons, and dumpsters to park on the opposite side of the street every other day after a snowfall of one-inch (1”) has occurred within the last twelve-hour period or has been predicted to occur within the next twelve-hour period.
2. Alternate Side Parking Restrictions shall require all motor vehicles, trailers, wagons, dumpsters, and all other obstacles to snow plowing vehicles, to park on the even numbered side of any public roadway on even numbered days and on the odd numbered side of any public roadway on odd numbered days during snow removal.
3. **DEFINITIONS:**
  - a. **EVEN NUMBERED SIDE:** The Even Numbered Side shall mean the side of the public roadway having building addresses with even numbers.
  - b. **ODD NUMBERED SIDE:** The Odd Numbered Side shall mean the side of the public roadway having building addresses with odd numbers.
  - c. **MISNUMBERED BUILDING:** Should a particular building be erroneously numbered, being the only odd numbered building on that side of the public roadway while all others are even, it shall not constitute a defense for parking violation.
  - d. **BLOCKS WITHOUT BUILDINGS:** Should any particular block be without buildings, the Even/Odd Numbered Side of the public roadway shall be determined by building addresses on adjoining blocks of that roadway.
  - e. **ONE SIDE PARKING:** One-Side Parking defines a restriction permanently prohibiting parking on one side of the street.
  - f. **RAILROAD STREET BUSINESS DISTRICT:** If no numbers are on the Railroad Street Business District Buildings, parking shall be on the North Side on even numbered days and on the South Side on odd numbered days.
