February 14, 2022

Regular meeting of the Norway City Council was called to order by Mayor Bruce Volz at 5:00 PM. Roll Call – Present: Kelly Luedtke, Ron Miller, Kevin Frese. Absent: Robby Miller.

Motion K. Frese seconded by K. Luedtke to accept agenda, minutes, treasurer's report, and bills presented. Motion carried, 3-0.

Mayor Volz opened the public hearing on the FY 22 Property Tax Max Levy Dollars at 5:02pm.

A brief explanation was given of the use of property tax dollars and the increase of approximately .10 per 1,000 was attributed to the raise in property valuations resulting in a significant increase to regular property tax levies. Hearing no concerns written or oral, motion Luedtke seconded by Frese to close the public hearing at 5:05pm. Motion carried 3-0.

Colton Dinsdale with Ferguson Water Works presented information on Ferguson water meter system. Meters and software system were discussed. Robby Miller joined the meeting at 5:10pm. Pricing list and finance options were explained. Council questions and concerns were addressed.

Motion Frese, seconded by Ron Miller to introduce resolution 22-03 approving maximum property tax dollars. Roll call: Aye-Luedtke, Ron Miller, Frese, and Robby Miller. Nay: None. Absent: None. Resolution 22-03 passes 4-0.

Appointment of officers was made by Mayor Volz- Mayor pro-tem, Ron Miller and park director, Mike Schulte.

Ordinance 333 amending alley maintenance was introduced by Ron Miller, seconded by Robby Miller. Aye: Luedtke, Robby Miller, Frese, and Ron Miller. Nay: None. Absent: None. Ordinance 333 passes the first reading.

Nuisance updates were given on letters sent from city attorney. Follow up will continue on other offenders.

Resolution 22-04 mileage resolution changing mileage rates according to IRS standard mileage rate was motioned by Luedtke and seconded by Frese. Resolution 22-04 passes 4-0.

Resolution 22-05 rock resolution establishing rock and delivery purchases was motioned by Frese and seconded by Ron Miller. Resolution 22-05 passes 4-0.

Resolution 22-06 Returned check fees/ NSF charge was motioned by Robby Miller and seconded by Ron Miller. Resolution 22-06 was passed 4-0.

Resolution 22-08 setting a date of March 14th for a public hearing on proposed lease of baseball diamond property was motioned by Ron Miller and seconded by Frese. Resolution 22-08 passed 4-0.

A budget workshop was conducted.

Resolution 22-07 setting the public hearing on March 14th for FY 23 budget was motioned by Luedtke and seconded by Frese. Resolution 22-07 passed 4-0.

Trees forever grant information was presented by the Mayor. More information to follow.
