

## ORDINANCE NO. 321

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE NO PARKING ZONE SET FORTH IN CHAPTER 69, PARKING REGULATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORWAY, IOWA:

Section 1. The Norway Municipal Code is hereby amended to repeal and replace Section 69.10 NO PARKING ZONES by adding #5 – No parking on W Johnson Street. Said section is hereby amended to read as follows:

No one shall stop, stand or park a vehicle in any of the following specifically designated no parking zones except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the direction of a peace officer or traffic control signal.

(Code of Iowa, Sec. 321.236[1])

1. On the east side of Younglove Street, commencing at its intersection with West Railroad Street and running northerly to the intersection of West Tuttle Street, a distance of approximately 250 feet along the east side of Younglove Street. (Loading and unloading for one-half hour in the area is allowed.)

2. On the east side of Sherman Street from the intersection with Railroad Street to the alley between Railroad Street and Tuttle Street.

3. On the east side of Union Street from the intersection with Washington Street to the intersection with Johnson Street.

4. On the south side of Railroad Street from the intersection with Euclid Street and running westerly, a distance of approximately 115 feet along the south side of Railroad Street.

5. On the north side of West Johnson St. from the intersection with Main Street and running westerly, a distance of approximately 100 feet along the north side of W Johnson St.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance is adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the 17<sup>th</sup> day of July 2020.
