

ORDINANCE NO. 302

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING MAINTENANCE OF MAILBOX REGULATIONS IN THE CITY RIGHT-OF-WAY SET FORTH IN TITLE III, COMMUNITY PROTECTION, CHAPTER 8, MAINTENANCE OF PARKING AREA AND SIDEWALKS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORWAY, IOWA:

Section 1. The Norway Municipal Code of 2000 is hereby amended to add Section 3-8-2 (4) Mailbox Regulations. Said section is hereby amended to read as follows:

3-8-2 ESTABLISHING MAILBOX REGULATIONS IN THE CITY RIGHT-OF-WAY. There shall be and thereby is hereby established Mailbox Regulations into City Right-Of-Way in the City of Norway, Iowa as follows:

(4) Installation of mailboxes shall be the sole responsibility of the property owner according to USPS regulations. Any work on city property (City Street or easement) to owner's property line that requires the removal or replacement of a mailbox is the property owner's responsibility. The Streets Division will only make repairs to private mailboxes when an incident occurs where a mailbox is damaged due to obvious operator error. The removal of snow and ice accumulations beyond normal snow plow operation in approach to mailbox is the responsibility of the property owner or resident.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance is adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after publication as required by law.
