

A Message from the Mayor of Norway:

4/4: Property Taxes continue to be a serious topic of conversation in town. To make it crystal clear, the **Millage Rate** that the City of Norway will add to your total property tax rate, for the FY25-26 season, has declined from: 14.49654 to 13.03329 – approximately 10% and some \$20,000 city-wide.

You may have become aware that the County has raised the value of everyone's property significantly; be aware that the City plays no part in determining your property's valuation.

3/24: Several weeks ago, while the City was working on its Fiscal: 25-26 budget, an error occurred in projecting the City's upcoming Property Tax Rate. As a result of that error, I know everyone was horrified to learn from the County Auditor that their City Property Taxes would be going up 57%.

Please be assured that the error has been rectified and the City's Tax Rate will not increase!
